Attending: John St. Hilaire, Joe Lahr, June Craig, Jim Stewart, Lou D'Allesandro, Earl Pierce of Verizon and Brian Christianson of Comcast.

The meeting began at 9:00 a.m.

Facts were heard from Earl Pierce and Brian Christianson about the position of their companies: i.e. MCAM is Comcast's customer; Comcast is Verizon's customer. The representatives of Verizon and Comcast had a tour of the facilities.

The basic fact was that Verizon needed a check from Comcast in the amount of \$7,597.93 for Verizon to do a search of paper records and physical search of the communications pipelines and manholes starting from the Bridge Street Bridge to determine if there is space in the pipes for a Comcast cable feed to MCAM at the 540 Commercial Street location.

The search process by Verizon is scheduled on a first come, first served basis beginning with a check, non-refundable to set the request on the schedule. Earl Pierce noted that the cost of the search could be more or less than \$7,597.93. In the event it was less there could be a credit to Comcast for future services which would in turn be granted to us.

Since there was no other way to get things rolling, it was agreed by the MCAM members attending that a check will be given to Brian Christianson, to facilitate the search for space in the pipelines for service to MCAM to be put on the schedule. It was estimated that we would have an answer about the pipeline capability by the end of July.
